COURSES OVERVIEW AND CONTENTS

Level 3 BTEC Diploma and Extended Diploma in Performing Arts Practice (Circus)

This two-year programme for ages 16 - 18 integrates practical skills alongside reflective practice. This qualification is the equivalent of three A-levels.

Foundation Degree -Contemporary Circus and Physical Theatre (FdA)

A two-year programme which includes circus discipline training and development, context, physical theatre, devising, stylistic forms and street theatre. Success in this programme provides the opportunity to apply to stay with us for a further year to achieve a full bachelor's degree with honours.

BA (Hons) -Contemporary Circus and Physical Theatre

This is a one-year top-up programme for students who have successfully completed the FdA and achieved a suitable progression grade. The year includes act creation, creative research and development and professional touring experience.

This one-year (or two-year part-time) master's programme is for those with a background in circus or other creative arts, who wish to develop their career into directing circus, or those who wish to deepen their performance practice.

BTEC (LEVEL 3)

Performing Arts Practice (Circus)

What you will study:

The BTEC course gives students the opportunity to develop a range of circus skills in multiple disciplines while gaining regular performance experience. This includes aerial, object manipulation, acrobatics, and balance alongside physical theatre, movement and devising.

Underpinning this practical skills development is rigorous academic study in which students investigate theatre practitioners, research circus styles, and explore the many employment opportunities available within the arts industry.

What you will get:

In your first year, you will gain a Foundation Diploma which equates to one and a half A-Levels. Successful students can apply to stay for a second year to top up to a full Extended Diploma, which equates to three A-Levels.

Where it could take you:

On completion of the BTEC Extended Diploma. students have a variety of progression pathway opportunities including higher education, other training schools in the UK or abroad, performance work or other careers.

This course is in partnership with City of Bristol College.

Entry requirements

GCSE English and Maths at grade 4 or above. It does not matter if you have never done any circus before as long as you have a willingness to learn and a moderate level of fitness.

We advise potential students to attend one of our open days so you can meet some of our team and participate in practical, discipline-based workshops.

DEGREE PROGRAMME IN CONTEMPORARY CIRCUS AND PHYSICAL THEATRE



THE FOUNDATION DEGREE

Our Foundation Degree (FdA) programme is your first step towards a rewarding and dynamic career in the performing arts. This two-year course is designed to provide you with a solid foundation in circus discipline training, physical theatre, and performance experience, opening the doors to a world of creativity and innovation.

Why Choose the FdA at Circomedia?

- Expert faculty: Our experienced and passionate instructors are dedicated to helping you develop your circus and theatre skills to your fullest potential.
- Diverse curriculum: The FdA curriculum covers a wide range of knowledge and skills, including acrobatics, juggling, physical theatre, aerial, and more. You'll gain a deep understanding of the world of circus and its place in contemporary performance.
- Access to well equipped facilities: Train in wellresourced facilities and performance spaces, providing you with an immersive learning experience.
- Real-world experience: Throughout your FdA journey, you will have opportunities to perform and collaborate with your peers, building a professional network and joining our outstanding pathways into the industry.

At the start of the programme all students will learn acrobatics, juggling and aerial and after five weeks tuition, will make choices to specialise in two of these disciplines. These specialisations will be taught alongside a variety of classes that support the development of physical skills and strength, including fitness and conditioning, handstands, tumbling, contemporary dance, acrodance, and physical theatre.

Over the two years students will also study the history and context of circus in contemporary society, will perform to live audiences multiple times, and will develop critical thinking and analytical thinking skills that can be transferred into the wider world of employment.

In addition to circus skills and disciplines students will learn about how to set up in business and the basics of teaching and learning so that they can fully engage with all career possibilities.



FdA entry requirements

- · 3 A levels with grades CDD or better, or
- BTFC extended diploma at MMP or over. or
- 80 UCAS points from qualifications at level 3
- Or be at least 21 years old with 3 years of experience in a relevant sector.
- All applicants must complete a successful audition and interview (audition fee of £60 per person).
- All applicants must demonstrate a good level of fitness and an understanding of theatre, circus and performance.



BA HONS DEGREE TOP UP

On successful completion of your FdA, you may apply to study at Circomedia for a third year, topping up your qualification to a full BA (Hons) Degree.

We offer a seamless and dynamic pathway from the FdA to the BA (Hons) top-up. Our programmes empower you to turn your passion into a profession.

On the BA (Hons), you will further enhance your circus discipline and physical skills, craft a repertoire of 'sellable' acts for a range of performance settings and delve into independent artistic research in your chosen circus discipline.


In the second half of the year, you will work independently to develop and produce a Final Major Project. This is a selfdevised solo or small group performance that gives you the opportunity to showcase everything you have learnt during your time at Circomedia.

The year culminates with the whole year group coming together to form a company, who will create, produce and then tour a show to a number of UK venues

MASTER'S DEGREE (MA) IN DIRECTING CIRCUS

Our master's degree in Directing Circus is the first and only one of its kind in the world. It has been developed to address a recognised need across the global circus community to create and support a new kind of performance director one who is aware of the huge potential and creative challenges of circus's own artistic context, and of the importance of audience experience and how this dynamic form can be voiced to the waiting public.

You don't need to have any circus experience before you join us, but an interest in making performance is essential for our students. Perhaps you have already trained or worked in directing or performance-based disciplines like theatre or dance, and we also welcome applications from those from non-performative disciplines like stage management, film-making, and the visual arts.

This course offers students the chance to study a range of research methodologies, as well as the roles, strategies, and practical skills of directing circus. It encourages students to explore the need for directors to simultaneously be authors, originators, and facilitators.

As an MA student, you'll engage in both group and independent learning, creating work with our BA students, our alumni and other performance professionals. You will have the chance to work with world leading professionals from the circus sector and debate the most recent developments in circus as it encounters other artistic disciplines. We will support you to make circus happen for the public in our bespoke venue, and will be engaged with you in workshops, lectures and seminars, all of which are open to your individual creative voice

Is the MA for you?

This course is for those who wish to be makers of circus. Applicants might have some practical experience of circus performance or directing in the arts, and you don't need to be an expert in either.

If you want to develop your directing abilities and are interested in investigating the public presentation of circus techniques across a wide spectrum of artistic expression, you will thrive here.

You can choose to be a director who does not set foot on stage, but you will also be very welcome to bring any of your own performance practices or expertise into your work as well as invite any existing professional contacts you may have to be present in your performance projects. You can work with your existing ensemble to create work in a supportive environment.

VOCATIONAL COURSES

Circomedia's vocational courses are offered in three-month blocks and cater to students seeking a non-academic path. They provide comprehensive training in creative and physical skills essential for circus and physical theatre performance, with flexible enrolment options.

The course is a way of building your creativity and technique without following the academic path. This course is available to anyone over the age of 18. You will study alongside our degree students but will not do the academic work or be linked to Bath Spa University with whom we deliver our degrees through a Franchise Partnership.

This course aims to help you develop as a well-rounded performer, matching your needs to an appropriate curriculum. It will introduce you to a range of circus disciplines, creative and performance skills and techniques, within Circomedia's supportive community. The courses may be taken in three-month to one-year blocks and you have the flexibility to extend the blocks if you wish.

Entry requirements

Students must be able to demonstrate a motivation to succeed on this programme, as well as physical skills or potential, creativity, enthusiasm, and a willingness to learn.

Fees

Tuition fees for the one-year course are £9,000.

Tuition fees for the three-month course are £3,000.

The vocational courses are not eligible for student finance.



WHY STUDY CIRCUS?

Contemporary circus is an exciting new area of performing arts; having emerged just over forty years ago, there is still so much to discover, develop and reveal to audiences and artists alike.

Circus can open doors to employment in these new and developing areas of performance as well as adding valuable additional skills and creativity to more traditional art forms. It can also improve physical and mental wellbeing, nurture imagination and contribute to developing communities.

Circus is an extremely physical art form existing on a dynamic intersection of athletic excellence and artistic creativity and expression. It demands continuous attention to develop skills, strength, stamina and resilience. Those who study or work in circus must have the ability to bounce back from setbacks and the passion to push forward. whether physically or in terms of their business.

Circus is inclusive and has a well-earned reputation of being an incredibly accepting and supportive industry for those who consider themselves outside of the mainstream or societal 'norm'. In 21st Century Britain, there

is a concerted effort taking place to increase the diversity of participants and performers in contemporary circus, and Circomedia is committed to facilitating this in any way we can.

This art form is also sustainable, with sitespecific and street-art style performances having a low environmental impact and shows in more traditional touring settings being creatively devised to suit all technical possibilities.

As a rapidly growing industry, employment opportunities in circus - as performers, technicians, teachers and other creatives continue to increase

Circomedia alumni work across the world, whether running and performing with a company in Belfast, managing the programme in Montreal's leading circus venue or touring internationally with Gandini Juggling, Performers Without Borders, Ockham's Razor, Mimbre or NoFitState. We support our graduates throughout their circus journey and are continuing to grow and celebrate our alumni network as they work in, influence and build the contemporary circus world.



WORKING ALONGSIDE A PROFESSIONAL THEATRE

An integral part of the Circomedia philosophy is to develop both minds and bodies. Nowhere is this seen more than in the relationships we create between our academy and our live events venue. We programme and present a multitude of professional shows at our unique, circus-rigged city centre venue, St Paul's Church, each year.

This venue is a high-tech, highly atmospheric space where we also present our own student performances to audiences in a fully professional context. All of this creativity is shaped around our academic offering to enable you to see great work, and have the opportunity to learn and speak with the directors and performers that we showcase.

Experience world-class performances

As part of the programme, you will be expected to attend a selection of these shows chosen by your tutors for their relevance to your studies. You will also benefit from heavily subsidised tickets and free entry to every student performance over the course of the year.

Learning the ropes

Our programmes incorporate the essential health and safety, rigging, stage management and technical elements of putting on a show alongside teaching circus disciplines and academic study.

Some of our students have gone on to complete technical internships with Circomedia, further diversifying their skills and broadening their employment opportunities in technical circus and theatre production.



WHERE CAN A DEGREE IN CIRCUS AND PERFORMING TAKE YOU?

Training at Circomedia opens up a range of future opportunities including further study, project-based employment with established companies, forming your own company and independent or freelance work.

Independent work

Freelance opportunities in circus and performance exist all year round, in festivals, cabaret, street performance, corporate entertainment and in the world of video and advertising, as well as in teaching, engagement and outreach work.

With Bristol being such a hive of creativity, our students are ideally placed to engage in the professional performance world. Circomedia has excellent relationships with local companies and agencies, such as Cirque Bijou, The Invisible Circus and Circus Citv. and they work with our students on a regular basis.

Forming a company

Among the many companies started by our past students are Ockham's Razor. Decadent Rabbit Cabaret, Acrojou, PanGottic and Tumble Circus

Further study

Circomedia graduates from our BTEC and Degree courses have taken the unique skills they've acquired here to other institutions around the world including Codarts, DOCH, École Nationale de Cirque (Montreal), Fontys, CNAC and the National Centre for Circus Arts











TRAINING SPACES

Circomedia is lucky to have two sites in which to train. Our Kingswood office and studios are set in a character-filled Victorian school building surrounded by leafy grounds on the outskirts of Bristol.


Our city centre site at St. Paul's Church is a restored 18th century church owned by The Churches Conservation Trust. This space is set in Portland Square, where beautiful Georgian buildings surround a green, just a stone's throw away from a bustling shopping centre in the city centre.

Our BTEC students are based in the city centre, and spend one day a week at Kingswood. Our higher education and masters degree students spend most of their time at Kingswood, where our teaching, academic and office staff are based.

Outside of our academy student's training hours, both of our sites are also home to our popular Youth Circus which teaches over 500 young people aged 4 - 18 circus skills lessons each term; our adult classes programme, including acrobatics, aerial arts, handstands and flying trapeze: and our professional membership scheme.









GETTING TO KNOW BRISTOL

Bristol is a thriving, vibrant, creative city in the South West of England. The city centre is set around an attractive and bustling harbour front with plenty of green spaces and a wealth of creative organisations and opportunities. The city is small enough to get to know quickly, but large enough to guarantee that there is always plenty to see, do and experience.

This vibrant location is home to people from a lively and diverse population and is particularly popular with students, who make up 9% of the population across the various colleges, universities and training academies located here. Many of those who study in Bristol love it so much that they choose to stay after they have graduated.

Bristol is renowned for its creativity and the Arts. Entertainment and Recreation industry ranks 9th in Bristol's Top 20 Industries (sparklines.co.uk).

As well as a buoyant circus scene, Bristol's creative industries include filmmaking, design, television, theatre, arts and music. Bristol is home to many acclaimed performance venues and touring companies and residents enjoy regular, city-wide events, activities and festivals throughout the year.

As well as catering to an exciting urban lifestyle, Bristol is also ideally located to reach some of the UK's finest countryside, coastlines and beaches. It is also less than two hours from London by train.
