Introduction

At Circomedia, we are committed to providing our students with the learning resources they need to succeed in their degree programmes. This policy outlines the resources available to our students and the guidelines for their use.

Library Resources

Circomedia students have access to the libraries of Circomedia and Bath Spa University, including their electronic resources. This includes books, journals, and databases that can be accessed online through the University's Library Catalogue. Students are required to obtain a Bath Spa University library card to borrow physical books from the library. The Circomedia library contains specialist books appropriate for degrees in Circus and Physical Theatre.

Teams

Circomedia students have access to other learning materials through Circomedia's Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) Teams. Teams is a platform that provides online access to course materials, discussion forums, and other learning resources.

Accessing through learning resources

To access the learning resources at Circomedia, visit the administration office to browse and sign out the books. To access the resources available through Bath Spa University, Circomedia students must have an active student account with the University. This provides access to the Library Catalogue and other university services.
